



When Peter J. Lassen, the founder of Montana, first met the young Danish architect Verner Panton in 1956, neither of them was aware that this would be the beginning of a close friendship and lifelong collaboration.

The strong bond and shared history between Verner Panton and Peter J. Lassen has made it a natural choice for Montana to manufacture several of Verner Panton's designs.





A life in colours

Verner Panton (1926–1998) is regarded as one of Denmark's most influential 20th-century furniture and interior designers. He is celebrated for his persistent use of bold colours and organic shapes, as well as his groundbreaking use of materials and, for its time, innovative approaches to industrial furniture production methods.

Panton is synonymous with vibrant colours and fluid, organic forms. However, during his collaboration with Peter Lassen in the 1970s, he also showcased an impressive approach to system thinking.

Throughout his career, Panton created innovative and futuristic designs using a variety of materials, particularly plastics and steel, and always embraced vibrant, dynamic colour schemes.



Panton Wire

A versatile shelving system designed by Verner Panton in 1971.

Use Panton Wire next to the bed or the sofa, as a light room divider – or hang the units on the wall.

The modules invite an infinite number of combinations and can be used everywhere: At home, in the store, as a bookshelf, in the bathroom.




PANTON WIRE Marble top plate is available for Panton Wire





PANTON WIRE Panton Wire in Black Red with Monarch top plate








Inlay shelf





Specifications

Materials

Panton Wire is made from 5 mm steel.

Components

Panton Wire is always supplied with feet and clips for joining, and two suspension brackets for wall mounting.

Max load

Each unit can bear loads of up to 40 kg when standing on the floor and 10 kg when mounted on the wall.

Stability

Modules higher than 70 cm must be secured to the wall with a security strip. All modules are delivered with one security strip.
